Dear DAWGS Family,

We, in the panhandle of Texas, cannot wait for spring! It was such a brutal winter for so many people across the nation and we certainly had our share here. We had snowstorms, ice storms, and freezing fog, but our particular favorites were the snowstorms followed by wind chills of 30 BELOW ZERO...it was soooo cold! Thankfully due to your tremendous help and support, our animals were safely nestled in their warm, hay-filled houses waiting for the weather to pass. The cold wreaked havoc on the shelter. First the pump went out in the water well...finally got it fixed. Then the water pipes were frozen and burst...got that fixed. Then the water well froze and we spent days trying to thaw it out and finally it too was fixed. Over a period of three weeks, we spent several days hauling a 500 gallon tank around the shelter to insure everyone received fresh water...and on a few days even the tank froze, so we had to buy water jugs and continually refill them at a nearby home. As soon as the temperatures hit 33 degrees, the dogs thought it was summer, lying on their backs basking in the sun. It was a difficult time for us but we persevered as we have during past weather ordeals...only because of your help.

This month marks our eighth anniversary and we are so grateful for all you have done to help us rescue and shelter 5,523 precious animals. Each one only wants the love and attention of a family and we thank you for the opportunity to help them find their forever homes. During the holidays we had our "Home for the Holidays and Forever Adoption Event" that began with the Merrick Pet Care Adoption Days in November and went through the end of December. During that time we adopted a total of 133 dogs and cats into caring homes. In January and February, in spite of the relentless weather, an additional 94 dogs and cats were adopted. Thanks to your support, since 2003, DAWGS has placed 4,824 deserving animals with loving new families.

Although each story is so special, here are just a few that touched our hearts:



SCRUFFY is a darling terrier with the kindest eyes. During one of the horrible storms, a kind woman, Jean, found him freezing in the cold. She immediately took him in, warmed him up and fed him a nice meal. She then called DAWGS for help. Fortunately one of our foster homes had an opening and was able to take him right in. When Jean arrived with him, she had made him a little care package of treats and essentials and asked that we let her know when he was adopted. We took Scruffy on adoption for several weeks but he never found the right family. We featured him on Studio 4 (a local NBC talk show) and Jean called us back. She had never forgotten Scruffy and had been so worried about him. After seeing him again on the show she decided she really needed him to be part of her family and contacted us to adopt him. Scuffy, usually shy, literally jumped for joy when he saw her. He is now in his forever home.





Squiggles and Super Y are two adorable kittens who were brought to our sanctuary by a nice family who had found them with their mother. Unfortunately, because of severe heath and financial hardships, the family could not keep all three cats. They felt the kittens would have a greater chance for adoption so they kept the mother and surrendered her babies. We took them for adoption for two months trying to find a home for them together, as they were inseparable, but many people wanted one kitty but not two. Then one day newlyweds came in looking for two kitties to be part of their family. As soon as the kittens wrapped their paws around the newlyweds fingers they were in love. Today they are in their forever homes and are so happy.





Here are the "designer dog" sisters, **Phoebe and Hershey**, Shih-Tzu / Rottweiler mixes...can you imagine?! Aside from being too cute for words, they have incredibly charming, fun-loving personalities. Their family had a severe crisis and had to surrender their puppies; they just had no choice and were devastated. The girls settled in at the shelter, and when the coldest weather passed, we were able to take them on mobile adoptions. A great couple came in, saw the two girls, and had to take them home, together, to be part of their family. It was one of our best adoptions. When little ones come in who have always been together, we try to keep that union intact and have been very fortunate to be able to do so. THANK YOU for helping make special moments like these possible for so many loving pets in our care.

As you know, DAWGS is a 501c3 non-profit organization that receives no federal, state or local government support. We rely on your donations, kindness and generosity, to enable us to give the animals in our care a second chance. Your continued support is essential to the lives of these animals.
